Groceries	Food (other than that sold for consumption in the store), pet food, drinks (other than those sold for consumption in the store), cleaning products, toiletries and household goods; but excludes petrol, clothing, DIY products, financial services, pharmaceuticals, newspapers, magazines, greetings cards, CDs, DVDs, video and audio tapes, toys, plants, flowers, perfumes, cosmetics, electrical appliances, kitchen hardware, gardening equipment, books, tobacco and tobacco products.

Grocery Retailer	A person who sells Groceries at the retail level.
Grocery Store	A retail store, a significant proportion of which is devoted to the sale of Groceries, but excludes stores operated by Limited Assortment Discounters and Frozen Food Retailers.

Invitation to Comment (ITC)	The Invitation to Comment published by the CMA on 12 March 2026, entitled 'Invitation to Comment on the potential designation of Aldi and Lidl under the Groceries Market Investigation (Controlled Land) Order 2010'.
Large Grocery Retailer (LGR)	A person designated from time to time as a Large Grocery Retailer in accordance with Article 3 of the Order.
Larger Grocery Store	A Grocery Store with a Net Sales Area of more than 1,000 square metres.

Limited Assortment Discounter (LAD)	A Grocery Retailer which sells a significantly more limited range of Groceries than a Large Grocery Retailer at a low price.
